



How to Share Housing with Others Until You're Up to Date with Your COVID Vaccines



Hygiene and Precaution

When coming back from the fields, wear a mask, wash your hands, use hand sanitizer, and wash worker's clothes separately.



Clean and Safe Household

In shared areas, stay at least 6 feet apart from people who may not be vaccinated. Don't share your tools and utensils. Keep all frequently touched surfaces clean.



People at High Risk

If you or anyone else in your household is at high risk (older adults and people with illnesses) and is unvaccinated, you should take additional physical distancing and hygiene precautions.



If Anyone Is Sick

If you or anyone else in your household has symptoms of COVID-19, you should isolate and not use shared areas. Everyone in the household should wear masks.



Medical Assistance

COVID-19 vaccines are safe. Everyone should get vaccinated to protect ourselves, our families, and friends.
